Applications are invited from eligible candidates for the following post in Nuclear Fuel Complex, Hyderabad and Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal, Tuticorin District, Tamil Nadu, Industrial Establishments under the Department of Atomic Energy, Government of India. The selected candidates, on appointment, are liable to serve in any of the above units and any constituent unit of the Department of Atomic Energy located in different parts of the country. SELECTION PROCEDURE:

In case of huge response to this advertisement, the screening will be restricted to those with higher percentage of marks and more experience or a screening test of the eligible candidates will be conducted at Hyderabad and Tuticorin in order to shortlist the candidates to be called for interview. Venue of the interview would be notified later.

Final selection of the candidates will be based on the performance of the candidates in Interview alone.

Application Fee: Rs.500/- to be paid in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of "PAY & ACCOUNTS OFFICER, NFC" payable at Hyderabad.

SC/ST, Women Candidates, Ex-Servicemen and Physically challenged persons (PWD) are exempted from payment of Application Fee. Attested copy of certificate to this effect should be attached by SC/ST/Ex-Servicemen/PWD while submitting the application.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Appointment to the post is subject to Medical Examination conducted by the Department.
2. Persons working under Central/State Government, Public Sector Undertakings, Autonomous bodies should submit "NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE" at the time of Interview.
3. Candidates must possess the prescribed qualification from a recognized University/Educational Institution on the date of applying for the post.
4. Departmental candidates who have rendered not less than 03 years continuous and regular service and holding posts which are in the same line or allied cadre as on the last date of application are eligible for relaxation in upper age limit for a maximum of 5 years.
5. **Ex-Servicemen:**

Age relaxation in the upper age limit for Ex-Servicemen shall be provided as per rules. An Ex-servicemen means a person who has served in any rank whether as a Combatant or Non-Combatant in the Regular Army, Navy, Air Force of the Indian Union and

 - i. Who retired from such service after earning his/her pension. This would also include persons who are retired/retire at their own request after having earned their pension; (or)
 - ii. Who has been released from such service on medical grounds attributable to military service/circumstances beyond his control and awarded medical or other disability pension;(or)
 - iii. Who has been released, otherwise than on his own request from such service as a result of reduction in establishment; (or)
 - iv. Who has been released from such service after completing the specific period of engagements, otherwise than at his own request or by way of dismissal or discharged on account of misconduct or inefficiency, and has been given a gratuity and includes personnel of the Territorial Army of the following categories, namely :
 - a. Pension holders for continuous embodied service.
 - b. Pension with disability attributable to military service and
 - c. Gallantry award winners.
6. Ex-Servicemen who have already secured employment in civil side under Central Government in Group C & D posts on regular basis after availing of the benefits of reservation given to Ex-Servicemen for their re-employment are NOT ELIGIBLE for claiming benefits of reservation under Ex-Servicemen category.
7. Relaxation in the upper age limit of 5 years shall be admissible to all persons who had ordinarily been domiciled in Kashmir division of the State of Jammu & Kashmir during the period from the 1st day of January, 1980 to 31st day of December, 1989 provided that the relaxation in the upper age limit for appearing at any examination shall be subject to the maximum number of chances permissible under the relevant rules.

Certificate regarding proof of residence – any person intending to avail of relaxation of age limit admissible as per Point No. 9, under Rule 3 shall submit a certificate from:

- a) The Dist. Magistrate in the Kashmir division within those jurisdiction he had ordinarily resided; or
 - b) Any other Authority designated in this behalf by the Government of Jammu & Kashmir to the effect that he had ordinarily been domiciled in the Kashmir Division of the State of Jammu & Kashmir during the period from the 1st day of January, 1980 to 31st day of December, 1989.
 - c) Relaxation in the upper age limit of 5 years shall be admissible to children/family members of those who died in the 1984 riots.
8. Period of experience as prescribed in the advertisement will be reckoned as on the last date of receipt of application i.e., **12.01.2018**.
 9. Posting of the selected candidates would be at the discretion of the Competent Authority as per the availability of vacancies in NFC, Hyderabad, Telangana and Zirconium Complex, Pazhayakayal, Tuticorin District, Tamil Nadu. They are liable to serve in any part of India, in any constituent unit of the Department of Atomic Energy.
 10. **AGE:** Age will be reckoned as on the last date of receipt of application mentioned in this advertisement.
 11. Applications, which are not in conformity with the requirements, may be rejected at any stage, and no correspondence will be entertained from the candidates.
 12. The applicants would be admitted to the examination on the basis of the information furnished by them in their application form. All the candidates are therefore advised to ensure that they fulfill all eligibility norms before applying for the post. Candidates should have the requisite Educational qualifications from recognized University/Institute and relevant experience as on the date of submission of the application. They should produce attested copies, certificates, mark sheets in support of having the requisite qualification and produce originals for verification at the time of Interview or as per the directions issued thereafter if any.
 13. On their appointment they will be governed by New Contributory Pension Scheme as notified by Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Government of India vide Notification No.F.No.5/7/2003-ECB & PR dated 22.12.2003.
 14. Candidates may ensure that they fill in the correct information and should understand that furnishing false information will entail them disqualified for written exam/interview/appointment.
 15. Vacancies shown above are provisional and subject to upward or downward variation.
 16. Nuclear Fuel Complex reserves the right to fill up all the posts or alter the number of posts or even to cancel the whole process of recruitment without assigning any reason.
 17. **TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE:**
Unemployed SC/ST candidates called for Selection test/interview from outstations will be eligible for reimbursement of Travel expenses limited to single SECOND CLASS railway fare from the place of normal residence to the place of Examination center and back by the shortest route as per rules subject to production of un-employment certificate issued by MP/MLA/Gazetted Officer of the area of residence. If concessional tickets are available, reimbursement will be limited to the concessional return fare only. Candidates are requested to submit their claims in the prescribed proforma available in the website along with copy of SC/ST Caste Certificate, tickets and un-employment certificate at the examination venue for reimbursement.

HOW TO APPLY:

1. Candidates are required to download the Application Form from the website www.nfc.gov.in and fill-in the details legibly with blue/black ink pen or typewritten the same on A4 size paper. The duly filled-in application should be placed in a cover and the cover should be superscribed as “**APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF SCIENTIFIC OFFICER ‘C’ (MEDICAL - GENERAL DUTY)**”, **POST CODE: 11701 against Advertisement No. NFC/01/2017**”.
2. A **recent passport size photograph** should be pasted on the right top corner of the application.
3. Candidates are required to submit the following documents along with the application:
 - a. Copies of certificates pertaining to educational qualification supported by appropriate marks sheets starting from X standard.
 - b. Copies of experience certificates clearly indicating the field of experience.
 - c. Copy of certificate in support of Date of Birth (Birth Certificate or Secondary School Certificate).
 - d. Copy of caste certificate issued by the Competent Authorities in the latest formats prescribed by the Government regarding their claim that they belong to SC/ST.
 - e. Copy of Disability certificate in the prescribed format from the appropriate authority clearly indicating the type and percentage of physical disability.
 - f. Copy of Discharge certificate in support of Ex-servicemen.
 - g. Persons working under Central/State Government, Public Sector Undertakings, Autonomous bodies should submit a declaration of informing their office. However, such candidates are required to produce “**NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE**” from their present employer at the time of appearing for interview, otherwise they will not be allowed to appear for interview.
 - h. Proof to the effect that the candidate has been affected by 1984 riots (if claiming age relaxation).
 - i. Certificate regarding domicile in Kashmir Division from 01.01.1980 to 31.12.1989 (if claiming age relaxation for Kashmir Division)
- NOTE: The above mentioned copies of certificates which ever applicable should be attached to the application by stapling/tagging with thread.**
4. The duly filled-in application form in the prescribed format along with necessary documents as above should be placed in a cover and the cover should be superscribed as “**APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF SCIENTIFIC OFFICER ‘C’ (MEDICAL - GENERAL DUTY)**”, **POST CODE: 11701 against Advertisement No. NFC/01/2017** should be sent to the **Administrative Officer, Recruitment – I, Nuclear Fuel Complex, ECIL Post, Hyderabad – 500 062** latest by **16:45 Hrs., on 12.01.2018**. Applications received beyond this date will be summarily rejected and NFC shall not be responsible for the delay in receipt of applications.

5. Note:
- a. Application which is illegible, incomplete, unsigned, not in prescribed format, without photo of the candidate, not enclosing attested photo copies of certificates and which is received after the last date prescribed, is liable to be rejected. **If the post applied for is not indicated on the top of the application and envelope, the same will not be entertained.**
 - b. The applicants are advised to strictly follow the instructions.
 - c. The particulars furnished by the applicant in the Application Form will be taken for further processing of the application. The candidate will be solely responsible for any wrong or incomplete information furnished in the application.
