General Instructions to the Candidates:

- 1. Candidates are advised to read carefully all the General instructions and ensure that they are eligible for the posts applied for as per the eligibility criteria stipulated, before applying.
- 2. The candidate should submit his/her application online (www.skltshu.ac.in).
- 3. The candidates are required to pay application / Registration fee of Rs. 1200/- online. In case of SC/ST/PH candidates Rs. 600/- which is non-refundable.
- 4. Candidates desirous of applying for more than one category posts should submit separate application for each category.
- 5. The candidate should belong to Telangana State. Local candidate criteria will be decided based on the period of study/residence for the period from 1st to 10th class.
- 6. No person shall be eligible if he/she is less than 18 years of age and more than 34 years of age as on 01-07-2021. However, there shall be relaxation of 5 years in case of candidates belonging to BC/SC/ST/PH candidates.
- 7. Candidates belonging to BC/SC/ST category should submit their caste certificate issued by the Competent Authority, at the time of verification.
- 8. The candidates must be able to speak, read and write Telugu language.
- 9. The appointment will be for a period of (5) years of Co-terminus with KVKs, whichever is earlier and subject to continuation of post(s).
- 10. Candidate claiming reservation under PH quota should furnish medical certificate issued by competent authority.
- 11. The Candidates posted in a particular KVK has to work at the same KVK and no request for transfer is permissible.
- 12. The Candidates appointed can be terminated without giving any notice in case his/her services are not satisfactory.
- 13. The Candidates will not have any right either for regularization for permanency.
- 14. Selected Candidates will have to join the post within 30 days from the date of issue of orders or date of dispatch of the orders whichever is later, failing which their appointment shall be automatically cancelled.
- 15. If the Candidate is found ineligible at any stage of recruitment process, he/she will be disqualified and his/her candidature will be cancelled. The Written test will be of 60 minutes duration with 80 multiple choice questions carrying ½ mark for each question concerning driving & vehicles.

The minimum qualifying marks in the online test shall be 40%. In case of SC/ST candidates it shall be 30%. A list will be prepared based on the combined marks i.e. marks obtained for Class in SSC, driving experience and online test.

Candidates in the ratio of 1:5 will be called for physical driving test from among the above list for which 40 marks are allotted. The candidates will be allowed for physical driving subject to fulfilling the medical test. The final merit list will be prepared after physical driving test.

While preparing merit list, in case of tie, the marks obtained in physical driving test will be considered for tie break. In case of further tie, the Date of Birth of candidate will be taken into account and the candidate older in age will be given preference.

B. Attenders:

Method of Recruitment:

- 1. The online computer based examination will be of the standard consistent with the minimum educational qualification prescribed i.e. 7th class qualification. The question paper of the computer based examination will be objective type with multiple choice answers for 80 marks only.
- 2. The computer based examination will be conducted for 80 questions (40 questions General Knowledge and 40 questions General English) and each question will carry one (01) mark. The duration of the online examination will be 90 minutes.
- 3. For the computer based examination in respect of General Knowledge subject, the question paper will be made available in English and Telugu languages.
- 4. The minimum qualifying marks to be secured in the computer based examination shall be 40% for O.C. candidates, 35% to the BC candidates and 30% for SC, ST & PH candidates, and these candidates alone will be called for oral interview.
- 5. The qualified candidates will be called for oral interview in the ratio of 1:5 of the notified vacancies.
- 6. No person shall be eligible for appointment to the service unless he/she satisfies the following conditions viz.
 - a. That he/she is of sound health, active habits and free from any bodily defects or infirmities rendering him/her unfit for the service.
 - b. That his/her character and antecedents are such as to qualify him/her for such service and
 - c. He / She is a citizen of India.
